**Addiction and Society (Dept. approval 6/13/06)**

1. Students will demonstrate knowledge of the basic definitions and types of addictions, including the basic causes of addiction and of addictions' impact on individuals, families and social institutions in order to function effectively in personal and professional arenas.
2. Students will demonstrate an understanding of the prevailing attitudes held regarding addiction within American society and of how these attitudes impact the treatment of persons with addictions in order to function effectively in personal and professional arenas.
3. Students will demonstrate knowledge of a variety of prevention and treatment methodologies and be able to compare their costs and benefits in order to function effectively in personal and professional arenas.
4. Students will demonstrate knowledge of how domestic violence and addictions interact and the effect this has on individuals, families and other social institutions in order to function effectively in personal and professional arenas.
5. Students will demonstrate a basic knowledge of varied programs and services which provide help to victims of domestic violence and batterers who have problems with addictive behavior.
6. Students will strengthen their abilities in college core competencies in reading, writing, oral communication and critical thinking in order to increase their success in this and other courses and in the workplace.
